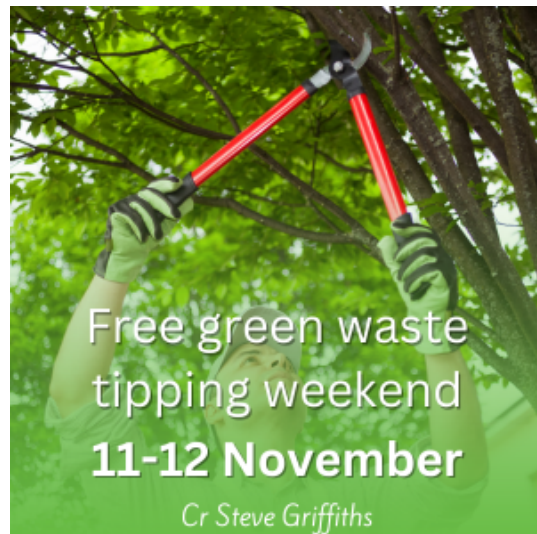
Free Green Waste Tipping Weekend
