Stable Swamp Creek Rocklea

At Brisbane City Council's meeting held Tuesday 12 November, I moved the following motion:

I move that:

The Lord Mayor, on behalf of Brisbane City Council, urgently reaches an agreement with his LNP State Government to unblock Stable Swamp Creek at Fauna Parade Park of weed species, silt, rubbish and debris that is causing a major increase in flooding for Rocklea residents and businesses.

In January 2024 Council officers supported the urgent cleaning of this site before the next storm season.

I am disappointed the Lord Mayor and his team voted against this motion.

You may wish to listen to the recent 4BC weekend breakfast interview with Olympia Kwitowski and Rocklea resident Jo Clark-Jones, where we discuss the lack of creek

maintenance of Stable Swamp Creek and how this inaction affects the community and businesses.

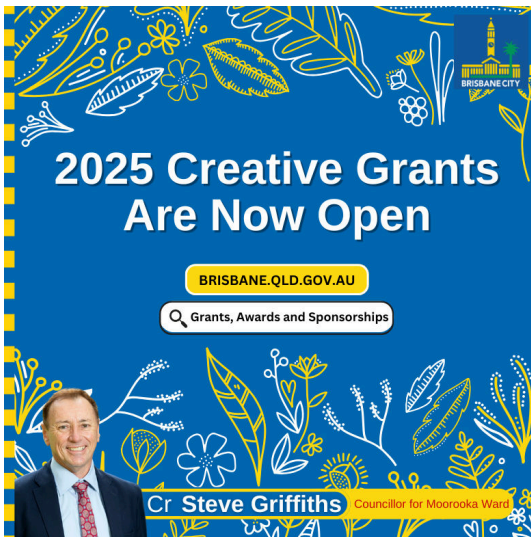

Tarragindi War Memorial Kindergarten - WasteSMART Early Learning Award Winner

Congratulations to Tarragindi War Memorial Kindergarten for winning the WasteSMART Early Learning Award!

You can find out why this award is well deserved below:

"The Tarragindi War Memorial Kindergarten is a community leader in sustainable practices, educating the children and in turn their families about

reuse and recycling practices to implement within their homes. Being a community kindy, they encourage donations of any kind, in particular, cardboard, bottle tops, wood, egg cartons, old cooking utensils and even clothes or materials. They only purchase essential items and opt for items that are recycled or environmentally friendly, often visiting recycle centres before purchasing new. When they need to dispose of something they place the items on Facebook Marketplace to try and rehome items instead of sending them to landfill.

The Kindy has a worm farm and compost bin for food scraps, coffee grounds, cardboard and leaf foliage, and collects containers in partnership with families and staff to help fundraise for further sustainable resources such as an extra worm farm.

They teach the children to care for the environment, through regularly collecting rubbish during their Bush Kindy Program and by participating in the annual Clean Up Australia Day.

Recently a member of the local community donated a street library to be stationed just outside the gate where anyone can donate and reuse preloved books."

Beaudesert Road near Evans Road, Moorooka

Project introduction

Brisbane City Council is planning minor safety and efficiency improvements on Beaudesert Road near Evans Road in Moorooka.

What will these works include?

As part of these works, we will be:

- removing the existing guardrails in the centre of Beaudesert Road
- installing a new concrete kerb and channel at the centre median island
- extending the right-turn pocket from Beaudesert Road into Evans Road
- installing new road line marking in line with the right-turn pocket extension.

Where are we doing this?

Works will take place south of the Beaudesert Road and Evans Road intersection in Moorooka, as shown on the image below.



Why are we doing this?

This work is part of our Road Construction Minor Traffic Density (RCMTD) program. This program aims to improve and enhance the safety, functionality and the overall quality of Council's road network.

Project benefits

This project aims to improve **safety and efficiency** for all road users by installing updated infrastructure aligned to current standards. Increasing the right-turn capacity from Beaudesert Road into Evans Road will help improve the overall operation of this intersection, helping you get home sooner and safer.


Next steps


Construction for this project is expected to start in early 2025.

We are committed to keeping the community informed and will provide another update with information before construction starts.

Night road resurfacing works

Evans Road from Tarragindi Road to Orange Grove Road – Salisbury

WHAT WORKS ARE COMING UP?

Brisbane City Council will be locating and marking underground services, profiling the road, applying a bitumen seal, and carrying out final asphalt resurfacing at the above location.

WHEN WILL THIS WORK TAKE PLACE?

Start	1 December 2024
Finish	19 December 2024
Times	7pm to 5am, Sun to Thur Nights

Works are subject to suitable weather and construction conditions.

WHAT DOES THIS WORK INCLUDE?

We have included a factsheet over the page with more information about how we resurface a road.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR ME?

If you live in or are travelling through the area, you may experience:

- noise, dust, and vibration from construction machinery
- strong odour during the potholing and asphalt laying process.
- changed traffic conditions, including minor traffic delays, no standing for traffic in the work zone, reduced speed limits, lane closures and detours.
- controlled access to driveways, with up to 15-minute wait periods
- increased street lighting and service of equipment up to an hour either side of start/finish times.

Traffic controllers will be on site to assist you accessing local properties. To meet workplace health and safety requirements, reversing beepers must be switched on.

WHY IS THIS WORK HAPPENING?

Our road resurfacing program will help make suburban streets smoother, safer, and more enjoyable to use every day.

By investing in our roads across every Council ward, we're ensuring our city's transport network continues to deliver a high-quality experience for users.

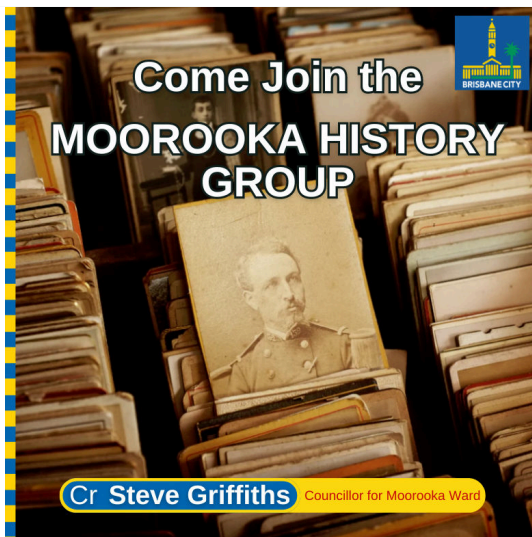

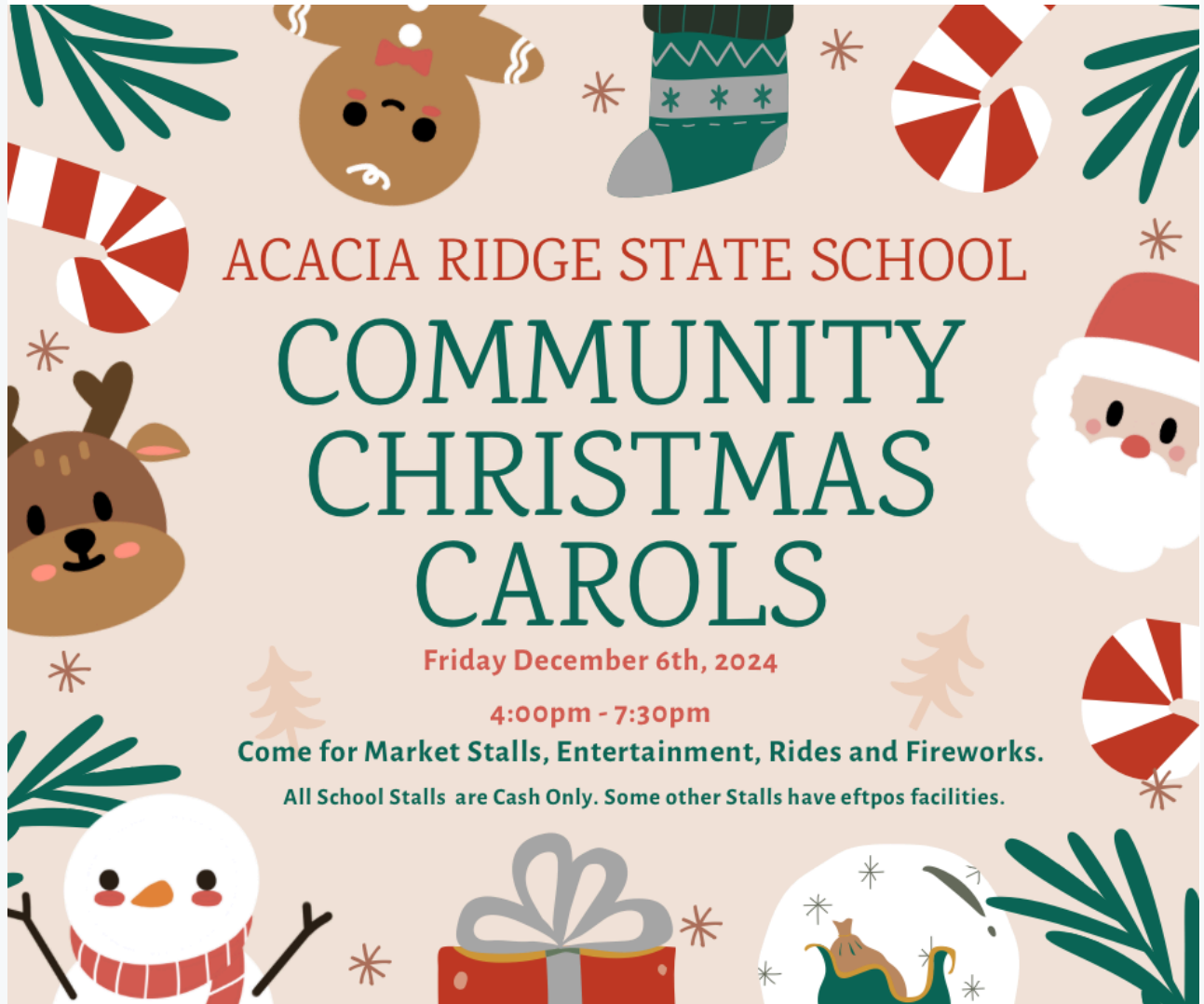
